LEVEL 1 MINIMAL ASSISTANCE

0-25% physical assistance with ADL's (Activities of Daily Living)
Client is continent
Client is ambulatory
Client requires supervision for safety
Client sleeps through the night
Companion
Caregiver will perform light housekeeping and laundry duties

LEVEL 2 MODERATE ASSISTANCE

25-50% physical intervention for ADL's
Client requires ambulation and transfer assistance
Client has manageable incontinence
Client requires verbal cues and set up for meals
Client may need to get up one time per night
Caregiver will perform light housekeeping and laundry duties
Client requires medication reminders

LEVEL 3 EXTENSIVE ASSISTANCE

50-100% physical assistance by the caregiver for ADL's
Client is elopement risk and may get up 2-3 times or more per night
Client is incontinent and requires catheter and/or diaper changing
Client requires mobility/ambulation assistance with devices (Hoyer lift)
Client requires full assistance with meals
Client requires medication setup
Caregiver will perform light housekeeping and laundry duties
Caregiver required to drive for errands and/or transportation of client
Client requires medication reminders
